Trey id going to build bat racks for dugouts at city field, along with putting white boards in dugouts.

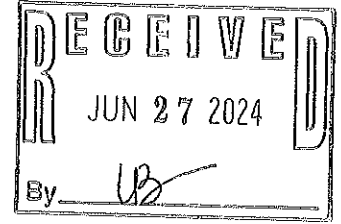
Last bid for pickleball court was several years ago and was approx. \$250,000. That is everything new. We need a committee to start looking into this being a reality.
