Meeting was called to order at 5:29PM

November agenda approved with revision adding to approve minutes from October.

No public participation

Financial- same as previous but adding \$2500 from Wallace Foundation for concrete for pads at Disc Golf Course

Gina is getting with Leslie to get basketballs ordered for school and park board basketball season.

Morgan accepted position as Tri County Rep again with same salary as last year.

Gina and Courtenay will chat with Morgan regarding how to get information out to coaches in a more timely manner when games are cancelled and/or re scheduled.

Disc golf course- first few pads are getting poured on Friday at noon. We are using Jamesport Concrete.

Wood Shed in Cameron donated rebar for disc golf course.

We will get a few sets of discs to have at the Penney library for people to check out.

Lauren is checking with DNR on location of where we can put port a potties at Disc golf course. Park Board has 2, plus one handicap one at the school.

Once course is done we will get sponsors for holes.

We will recognize partners on signage- Coles parents, the Wood Shed, Wallace Foundation, Jamesport concrete, and others who have helped along the way.

Water plant still approx 10 years out for being recreational due to Little Otter Creek not being worked on at the moment.

City fields- Trey Lund is getting us a quote on new concession stand. \$50,000 approx to re-create one at the school.

Gina mentioned applying for another Royals grant.

Cost guestimate to put poles and lights up at city field is \$30,000 to \$40,000. Lights would be used by flag football, adult softball league (if one is formed), an additional practice field at nights for baseball, etc.

Plan is to have bid from Trey by Dec 10th City Council meeting so we can present it to the City Council.

Lauren addressed Pickleball/tennis courts. She is going to approach contractor doing our road work and see if any asphalt that is left can be used for the courts.

Gina made motion to adjourn meeting at 6:20pm, Rick second.
